		The Apollo performers cross to DSL.
		A white DJ enters DSR. He has a mic which is linked to a partable tape recorder. He talks into bis mic apprine lights build on stage.
	DJ:	Testing, testing, One to three
		The PERFORMERS are about to leave the stage but stop when the hear the DJ start talking.
	DJ:	Helo again boppers, tonight I'm hot on the trail of the up and oming group Buddy Holly and The Crionets. (amazed). And listeners you'll never guess where I am? I'm ackstage at the Apollo Theatre in Harlem New York.
	T	The PERFORMERS walk across to the D who is kneeling over his tape recorder and stand over him.
	DJ:	Hi Ma'am you got a problem?
	PERF A:	Yeah, how the hell did you get in here?
		DJ STANDS
	DJ:	I walked.
	PERF A:	Then you can walk right out again.
	DJ:	No, thank youI've got an interview with Buddy Holly for my radio show.
		The Performer laughs
	PERF A:	You're wasting your time man. There's no way the Crickets will want to talk to you, white boy, no way no how so hit the road Jack.
	DJ:	I'll stay if you don't mind.
	PERF B:	(threatening) Yeah we do mind, whitey.
		JOE, JERRY and the 4TH CRICKET enter SL

DJ:	Hi fellas, where's Buddy? (the DJ is relieved he has company)
JOE:	He's coming.
	The PERFORMERS sees The Crickets and all double-take.
PERF A:	It's a Goddamn epidemic
	The PERFORMER walks cool and slow over to the Crickets and takes a long hard stare at them.
JOE:	(To PERFORMER) What you lookin' at ma'am?
PERF A:	I ain't lookin' - I'm staring! You got business here man?
JERRY:	Sure have - we're on next.
PERF A:	You! You are going out there!
JERRY:	Yeah.
	The PERFORMERS burst out laughing.
JERRY:	What's so funny?
PERF A:	You guys are jiving me right, the Crickets are on next.
JOE:	That's us - we're the Crickets!
	The PERFORMERS react
PERF B:	You're a Cricket!!!
JOE:	Sure I'm a Cricket. I'm a Cricket, and he's a Cricket an' he's a Cricket too.
PERFORMERS:	(Mimic) I'm a Cricket, he's a Cricket, he's a Cricket too.
	The Performers laugh.
PERF A:	Well if you're a Cricket what colour's Buddy Holly?
	BUDDY moves quickly on and past the PERFORMERS, on his way to the DJ. He wears his white suit and carries his guitar. He now wears all black curved frame glasses. The PERFORMERS watch him cross in amazement.

PERF A:	(Squeaks)white?
	The PERFORMERS react then laugh hysterically.
JERRY:	What's the matter with y'all man?
	The PERFORMER looks towards the stage area, then back at the CRICKETS
PERF A:	You guys are gonna go out there and get
	The PERFORMER thinks better of warning them.
PERF A:	nuthin', nuthin' at all. $\mathbf{\omega} \mathbf{Z}$ (
\mathbf{h}	BUDDY is now with the DJ. BUDDY fill get nervous as the PERFORMERS cross to him and stare. Buddy smiles at them puzzlea, but the penny will not drop until later
DJ:	OK Buddy, I've done the intro so it's just straight n.
BUDDY:	Ok.
DJ:	(Turns of the tape) Hi Buddy, and welcame to New York.
BUDDY:	Hi, it's really great to be here and I'r just having a ball.
DJ:	OKWell good for you Buddy. Unink what you're doing here is great.
BUDDY:	Well thank you.
DJ:	So Buddy, how does inteel to have three records in the charts?
BUDDY:	Oh man it's indedible. Yeah yeah, we have the three going right now. Our first one was 'That'll Be The Day'. And that went to Number One in two weeks. And then we had a new one by the Crickets called 'Oh Boy' and 'Not Fade Away'. And then there's another one just out, it's the same group but its under my name, I don't show why they did it that way but it went obcurder my name called 'Peggy Sue' and 'Everyday'.
