ELIJAH is the last surviving knight of Camelot (living incognito in Brooklyn, NY). Read this as a monologue.

INT. SPIRE OF ST GEORGE ET LA DAME DU LAC CHURCH.

MUSIC: "Gladys Magic Music"

SFX: Elijah stuffs clothes into a leather bag in a rush.

ELIJAH

I travelled all over the world, and in over one thousand years, Excalibur never sang. Then 100 years ago, I stumble into Brooklyn on accident, and Excalibur sang softly, and glowed a tiny bit. And every year since, Excalibur glows a little bit brighter.

When we get to Camelot, the first thing we'll do is find an inn, get settled for the night, have some roasted potatoes and homestew.

And when you get there, it won't be like Brooklyn, you can say hi to everyone you meet! The Fae Folk. The Beasts of the Royal Forrest. Mages and Sprites and all kinds of tribes. They all LOVE dragons. I should've taken you long ago.

And it's easy to get there. All we need are two things. Number one, Excalibur. And number two, some magic words.

SFX: With a swipe and scraping of metal, and a squeeze of the hilt, Elijah holds Excalibur. Elijah takes a deep breath, then another deep breath. Finally a third. There's a hum.

ELIJAH (CONT'D)

(Arabic)

Fath Bab CAMELOT!

SFX: There's an etheral sound that pulses once, twice, then a third time—a small thunderclap, then stone scraping along the ground like doors opening. The crackling of electricity, along with a low, electrical hum. The Door is open.

<u>JAMES</u> is the caring but busy Dad of Tisha and Michael. Please read these lines as dialogue.

SFX: Tisha gets up, takes off her helmet, and sets down the tube while she's talking.

JAMES

Mom made spaghetti babygirl. Hey, I heard you went outside today on a Saturday! I woulda thought you'd be at the library or in your room reading your books!

You met a stranger outside. The Church Man. Tisha, we have rules about strangers. You should stick with friends your own age. Right?

SFX: The family goes back to eating. It's QUIET except for eating. The mood's broken.

JAMES (CONT'D)

Tell me what the new library books are about. Stories about mythology. Those stories are fun, but it's like your mom says, sometimes they convince people you gotta be born special to be important. But Tisha, you have to know, you don't have to be born special to be special.
